SPARKLING

Prosecco Brut Argeo, Ruggeri NV , Veneto, Italy £35
Delicate, zesty Prosecco, exuding green apples and citrus.

Classic Reserve, Hattingley Valley NV United Kingdom £55
The Classic Reserve is an elegant bronze gold colour with lemon pith, nougat and zesty citrus on the nose. A delicate, light honey note to the palate with juicy acidity and vibrant orchard fruits. Conference pears, a hint of nuts with a complex finish.

Cuvee' Prestige Ca Del Bosco NV, Franciacorta Italy £85
75% Chardonnay, 15% Pinot Noir, 10% Pinot Blanc. While Prosecco may be the better-known sparkling wine of Italy, Franciacorta is its most serious, and Italy's answer to Champagne. The Ca' del Bosco's Franciacorta is the benchmark of the genre – crisp, clean, and pure, redolent of spring flowers, pears, lemon curd and almond notes.

CHAMPAGNE FRANCE

Brut Mosaique, Champagn Jacquart NV £75
Lightly elegant Champagne, perfumed with pear and fresh bread, condensing into gingerbread and fresh fruit on the tongue.

Brut Mosaique Rose, Champagne Jacquart NV £85
Pink fizz that bubbles with ripe redcurrants, cherries, wild strawberries and plums.

Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label , Champagne NV £85
Well known for both its full-bodied and consistent style, with aromas and flavours of baked apple, biscuit and brioche. A black grape dominated blend, using 50% Pinot Noir and 20% Pinot Meunier together with 30% Chardonnay. A blend of over 50 crus, mostly Premier and Grand Cru, with over 25% reserve wines.

Blanc De Blanc Ruinart , Champagne NV £190
A glorious Chardonnay Champagne, vibrating with nectarines, pineapples and peaches, preceded by a delicate, defining spritz of citrus.

Dom Perignon Brut Champagne 2010 £200
Pale-yellow with fine, persistent bubbles. Complex green-apple & leafy aromas are, followed by yeasty/bready notes & vegemite (yeast extract), with toastiness from lees age & bottle development. Intense mineral & lemon fruit runs through the wine & lees aging adds a creamy texture. There are bready/toasty/yeasty flavors, but less vegemite influence. The mid-weight wine is precise, with crisp acidity, balanced by honeyed fruit & a long, fine finish.

ROSE' WINE

Rose Sicilia Planeta , Sicily 2021 £31
The wine is silky smooth, light and fresh with no angularity and a beautiful finish.

Cotes de Provence Rose, Domaine de l'Amour, La Vidaubanaise , France 2022 £35
Provençal rosé, fragrant and elegant as southern sunshine, full of strawberries, cherries, citrus and crushed red apples.

ITALY

Cortese Amonte Cantine Volpi, Piedmont 2021 £26
Piedmont white from the Cortese grape, delicately citrusy and breathing fresh-mown grass and almonds.

Puiatti Pinot Grigio, Friuli Venezia Giulia 2021 £32
It is a wine with great personality and an assertive, lingering and tangy flavour. This Friuli corner close to Slovenia, produce one of the best Pinot Grigio quality of Italy.

La Segreta Grillo, Planeta Sicilia DOC 2021 £33
Grillo is the rounded white variety indigenous to Sicily; this version is perfumed with citrus and juicy with white peach and tropical fruit.

Just Molamatta, Marco Felluga, Friuli DOC 2021 £34
Straw yellow in colour. It is characterized by an elegant bouquet of fresh fruits. It coats the palate, is fruity and mineral and the finish confirms the wellbalanced aromas presented on the nose.

Gavi di Gavi DOCG Organic, Fontanafredda, Piedmont DOCG 2021 £38
Gavi di Gavi is one of the most fashionable white wines Italy makes and this delicately floral example, exuding lemons, lilies of the valley and green apples, makes it easy to see why.

Pomino Bianco, Frescobaldi, Tuscany 2021 £44
The bouquet is rich with floral notes, with honeysuckle as the prevalent aroma. The aromas of Pomino Bianco are markedly persistent when you taste it. This is, in part, thanks to the wine being aged on lees in the months following vinification.

Chardonnay, Planeta Sicily DOC 2021 £62
A rich, golden Chardonnay that bundles yellow peaches, acacia honey and a touch of marzipan into a net of fine-thread acidity, then hits you with a homely waft of toast.

FRANCE

Picpoul de Pinet, Les Prades Languedoc-Russillon 2021 £33
This subtle, fresh white from this popular southern French grape offers flowers on the nose and refreshing citrus, mainly lemon and tangy grapefruit, on the palate.

Riesling, Trimbach, Alsace 2019 £48
The Trimbach Classic Riesling is dry, elegant and restrained, with a deliciously food-friendly bite. In Alsace this edge is what goes so well with, and cuts straight through, the local cuisine. Goose, sauerkraut and onion quiche are the watchwords here.

Chablis, Domaine de Vauroux, Burgundy £56
With the acidity of a just-bitten apple and the pure minerality of a fresh-washed stone, this is crisp and stylish, with peach, pear and steel on the finish.

Sancerre "La Terre des Anges", Domaine Laporte, Loire Valley 2021 £58
While young, the wine's ripe fruits give it a soft texture. Acidity and green fruits are filled with warm apple and pear flavors to give a fine contrast between the richness and cooler aftertaste.

Pouilly-Fuisse, Domaine Ferret, Burgundy 2020 £75
Top of the range Pouilly-Fuissé, full of stone fruits and a creamy note of hazelnut butter, the nose a bouquet of acacia flowers and spice.

REST OF EUROPE

- Embrujo Verdejo Organic, Bodegas Verum, Rueda Spain 2022 £27
Dry, restrained Spanish white, hay and fennel flavours rounded out by plums and pears, ending on a restrained wash of citrus.
- Monte Llano Blanco Rioja, Ramon Bilbao, Rioja Spain 2021 £33
Tropical, vibrant white Rioja with a whiff of banana and a refreshing perfume of lemon and lime.
- 'Alba Martin', Martin Codax, Rias Baixas Spain 2021 £36
Vivid straw-yellow green colour. Bright and shiny. Intense nose and elegant aromas with hints of white stone fruits and white flowers. The proximity to the sea gives the wine its freshness and saltiness and the granitic soils enhance its natural minerality. The wine is rounded and full-bodied, with a light petillance that adds to its vivacious sense of freshness. Impressive persistence on the finish.
- Douro White, Quinta Do Crasto, Portugal 2021 £36
Crisp white from northern Portugal, packed with lemons, camomile and crunchy green apples.
- Assyrtiko, Ktima Kir-Yianni, Macedonia , Greece 2021 £38
Lovely, stony white wine from this admired Greek grape variety, perfumed with citrus and flowers and rounded out by flavours of white peach.

NEW WORLD

- Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, Glazebrook, New Zealand 2022 £35
Crisp and zesty with moments of citrus and grapefruit, crunchy green apple, juicy peach and passionfruit with fresh garden herbs.
- Chardonnay Reserva, Vina Leyda, Chile 2021 £35
As a tribute to the varietal pureness, this is a fruit driven style and unoaked Chardonnay. It has ripe citrus and semitropical hints of kiwi and cherimoya. It has sweet and leesy texture, balanced with a juicy finish.
- Petit Chenin Blanc, Ken Forrester Wines ,Western Cape South Africa 2021 £36
Perfect everyday drinking wine. A youthful fresh wine with quince and pear drop flavours. Earlier picked freshness shows on palate with crunchy green apple and grapefruit flavours.
- Hills and Valleys Riesling, Pikes, Clare Valley, Australia 2021 £38
Brilliant pale green with a fresh, thier hills & Valleys Riesling has a vibrant nose displaying aromas of lemon, granny smith apple and some perfume and floral notes. Hills & Valley Riesling is fresh and crisp with a palate full of lemon, lime and apple flavors.
- Chardonnay, Bogle Vineyards, California , USA 2020 £45
A treat of a Chardonnay from California, with green apples, pears and pineapples on the nose and butterscotch and vanilla, balanced by fresh acidity, on the tongue.

ITALY

- Barbera Amonte, Cantine Volpi, Piedmont 2019** £26
Bright, fruity, easy-drinking red, cheerfully giving out blueberries, cherries and raspberries.
- La Segreta Nero d'Avola , Planeta Sicilia DOC 2020** £26
Rich, spicy Nero d'Avola grape indigenous to Sicily, with cocoa, spice and plush dark fruit.
- Primitivo Organic, Varvaglione, IGT Puglia 2020** £35
Intense Primitivo from southern Italy, lush with blackberries and currants and elegantly perfumed with nutmeg, chocolate, liquorice and vanilla.
- Colle Cavalieri Cantina Tollo, Montepulciano D'Abruzzo DOP 2020** £35
Velvety scent of violet, hint of black cherry with a slightly tannic aftertaste
- Chianti Classico Borgo Salcentino DOCG, Tuscany 2017** £36
A well-structured, well balanced wine with ripe cherry fruit and raspberries on the nose and a rich, savoury character on the palate. Smooth and velvety tannins follow with a good length.
- Barbera D'Alba Paolina Ca' Del Baio DOC ,Piedmont 2018** £36
Deep ruby red in colour with purplish highlights. Vinous and intensely fruity, with nice hints of red currants and raspberries.

FRANCE

- Les Mougeottes Pinot Noir, IGP Pays d'Oc Languedoc-Roussillon 2021** £32
Clean and precise bouquet with black cherries and raspberry aromas. The palate is medium-bodied with sappy red berry fruit and a silky long finish.
- Cotes du Rhone Rouge, Terra, Maison Sinnae, Rhone Valley 2020** £33
Bright and elegant red from the southern Rhône, offering a perfume of herb- and pepper-tinged cherries and a mouthful of strawberry fruit. Very easy-drinking, with soft tannins.
- Brouilly, Louis Tete, Burgundy 2021** £43
A light, juicy Beaujolais, loaded with ripe fruit character and aromas of crushed strawberries and forest fruits.
- Chateau Dubard Bel-Air, Puisseguin Saint-Emilion, Bordeaux 2018** £49
A charming wine, full of ripe plum and blueberry fruit, supported by toasty oak. Ample-textured, with juicy fruit balanced by firm tannins and great structure.
- Bourgogne Cote d'Or Pinot Noir, Nuiton-Beaunoy, Burgundy 2018** £50
Cherry red colour with dark ruby reflections. The nose offers aromas of cherries, blackcurrant and spices. On the palate it is round and delicate, with fine tannins, leading to a fresh finish.
- Pessac-Leognan Rouge, Chateau Valoux, Bordeaux 2017** £55
Deep ruby in colour with an expressive nose of black fruits with toasted aromas. Perfect balance on the palate with silky tannins, fresh acidity and superb concentration of flavours.

REST OF EUROPE

- Paranga Red, Ktima Kir-Yianni , Macedonia Greece 2020** £31
Red forest fruits and cherries, supplemented by a perfume of rose petals, give this light-bodied Macedonian red vibrancy, while a scattering of spice adds sensuality to the mix.
- Douro Red, Quinta do Crasto, Portugal 2019** £37
Dark and richly aromatic, with heady flavours of ripe red berries, violet and spice.
- Rioja Crianza, Sierra Cantabria, Spain 2018** £42
Smooth, elegant Rioja, brimming with ripe cherries and other red fruit, the nose a sophisticated combination of spice, cocoa and a wisp of smoke.
- Crianza Organic, Cruz de Alba, Ribeira Del Duero Spain 2019** £52
This is a wine with a marked deep red colour, with a youthful bluish tint at the rim. On the nose it is rich in nuances: intense, fresh, with sparks of ripe fruit and spices, integrated with a balanced, elegant and pleasant oakiness. On the palate it is silky, full bodied and intense, with a long lingering finish.
- Rioja Gran Reserva, Sierra Cantabria, Spain 2012** £70
Smoky, complex Gran Reserva Rioja, dizzyingly perfumed with truffle, vanilla, toast and notes of balsamic, the mouth packed with red fruit.

NEW WORLD

- Amaru Malbec, El Esteco, Calchaqui Valley Argentina 2021** £35
A very well balanced wine with soft tannins, notes of baked plums, raisins & hints of chocolate and vanilla oak.
- The Stump Jump Shiraz, d'Arenberg, McLaren Vale Australia 2019** £36
Powerful yet friendly Shiraz from McLaren Vale in South Australia, all spice and dark chocolate on the nose with cherries, blackberries and flowers in the mouth.
- Reserve Pat's Garden, Ken Forrester Wines , Western Cape S.Africa 2019** £45
Hints of coffee, chocolate and ripe berry fruits supported by smooth, firm tannin for soft early drinking.
- MOMO Pinot Noir Organic, Seresin Estate, Marlborough New Zealand 2019** £55
Lively, concentrated Pinot Noir spilling over with raspberries and cherries, with a faint perfume of flowers on the finish.
- Sonoma Cabernet Sauvignon, Louis Martini, California USA 2018** £60
Cabernet Sauvignon from California's renowned Napa Valley, almost jammy with black plums and blackcurrants and lightly spiced on the nose.

SELECTION OF FINE RED WINES

- Barolo di Serralunga d'Alba DOCG, Fontanafredda, Piedmont Italy 2018** £70
Full-bodied, velvety and intense, this Barolo is heady with vanilla, dried roses and woodland undergrowth.
- Brunello di Montalcino, Il Poggione, Tuscany Italy 2017** £75
A seductive Brunello di Montalcino, so fragrant with fruit, leather and spice you could wear it as aftershave.
- Amarone Valpantena DOCG, Bertani, Veneto Italy 2019** £80
Deep dark ruby with a violet rim. Notes of black and sour cherries, berries, spices and dried fruit. The palate is creamy with soft tannins and integrated oak. A lighter, fruitier and younger version of Bertani's icon Amarone Classico.
- Turriga Isola Dei Nuraghi Argiolas, Sardinia 2018** £90
Here is a wonderful Sardinian red from the family-run Argiolas winery. A rich and complex nose, with a beautifully structured palate and a long finish. Pairs well with game, red meat and mature cheeses.
- Amarone della Valpolicella Classico, Zenato, Veneto 2016** £95
From a quality-focused family winery, this is big and powerful, even for an Amarone. Rich and plush-textured with luscious chocolate, licorice, prune, nutty and floral flavours.
- Il Pino Tenuta Di Biserno, Antinori, Tuscany 2018** £95
This is a velvety and nicely extracted expression that delivers textbook aromas of dark fruit, dried blackberry, spice, leather, tar and tobacco.
- Brunello Di Montalcino Casanova Di Neri, Tuscany, Italy 2016** £95
This classic expression displays raspberry, tar, hazelnut, dried fig, asphalt and some crushed chalk. The wine is streamlined and compact in terms of mouthfeel, giving us an accessible Brunello from Montalcino estate.
- Mercurey 1er Cru Clos des Barraults Rouge, Michel Juillot, Burgundy 2017** £80
Classic Mercurey Premier Cru, a concentrated rush of fruit on the palate and an appealing woody perfume on the nose; cherries and redcurrants blend with cedar and oak, to exciting effect.
- Maragux Origine De Demistral, Denis Lurton Bordeaux 2018** £80
Spicy, alluring Bordeaux red, offering a persistent perfume of wildflower and a mouthful of crushed blackcurrant.
- Pauillac, La Fleur de Haut-Bages Liberal, Bordeaux 2016** £95
A blend of 80% cabernet sauvignon and 20% merlot, it has well-integrated tannins for a rounded full-bodied structure, plenty of rich cassis, with cedar and cigar box nuances from ageing in French oak barrels for 16 months.
- Nuits-Saint-Georges Joseph Drouhin, Burgundy 2014** £155
Deep red colour. The aromas are powerful and elegant, with notes of cherry and blackberry, as well as hints of cedar wood evolving towards gamey touches. On the palate: beautiful balance between structure and softness.
- Saint-Julien, Chateau Talbot 4eme Cru Classe, Bordeaux 2017** £180
Talbot has produced an elegant, fresh and carefully structured 2017. This has plenty of finesse and rich black fruit flavours.
