SPARKLING

Prosecco Brut Argeo, Ruggeri NV, Veneto, Italy £38

Delicate, zesty Prosecco, exuding green apples and citrus.

Classic Reserve, Hattingley Valley NV, United Kingdom £55

The Classic Reserve is an elegant bronze gold colour with lemon pith, nougat and zesty citrus on the nose. A delicate, light honey note to the palate with juicy acidity and vibrant orchard fruits. Conference pears, a hint of nuts with a complex finish.

Mosnel Brut NV, Franciacorta, Italy £60

Right from its entry it conquers the palate and keeps it hostage, light-hearted yet firmly, progressing to a finale that is forthright and self-assured lush and eminently enjoyable

CHAMPAGNE FRANCE

Brut Mosaïque, Champagne Jacquart NV £78

Lightly elegant Champagne, perfumed with pear and fresh bread, condensing into gingerbread and fresh fruit on the tongue.

Brut Mosaïque Rose, Champagne Jacquart NV £95

Pink fizz that bubbles with ripe redcurrants, cherries, wild strawberries and plums.

Brut Reserve Tattinger NV £95

A blend of the three Champagne varieties, slightly heavier on the Chardonnay, this is a crisp, citrusy sparkling wine with subtle notes of brioche and white flowers; in the mouth it is fruity, honeyed and moreish.

Laurent Perrier Cuvée Rose NV £150

A glorious sparkling rosé in an old-fashioned bottle that fizzes as much with fine acidity as with bubbles and fills the mouth with fragrant red fruit.

Blanc De Blanc Ruinart, Champagne NV £190

A glorious Chardonnay Champagne, vibrating with nectarines, pineapples and peaches, preceded by a delicate, defining spritz of citrus.



ITALY WHITES

- 2022 Cortese Amonte, Volpi, Piemonte IGT £27
Piedmont white from the Cortese grape, delicately citrusy and breathing fresh-mown grass and almonds.
- 2022 Mandrarossa Chardonnay, Sicilia DOC £34
Pale straw yellow in colour, with delicate green hues. On the nose, it has aromas of orange peel, oleander flower and prickly pear. The palate is powerful with good minerality and a long finish.
- 2022 Puiatti Pinot Grigio, Friuli IGT £34
The wine has intense color, complex nose with notes of white peach, pear, stone. The palate is structured with a long finish.
- 2023 Pecorino Barba, Abruzzo IGT £34
Ample with sweet orchard fruits and subtle spice, fermented in stainless steel tanks to keep its fruit freshness and tang.
- 2023 La Segreta Grillo Planeta, Sicilia DOC £34
Grillo is the rounded white variety indigenous to Sicily; this version is perfumed with citrus and juicy with white peach and tropical fruit.
- 2022 Just Molamatta Doc Friuli, Marco Felluga (Pinot b,Ribolla,Friul) £35
Straw yellow in colour. It is characterized by an elegant bouquet of fresh fruits. It coats the palate, is fruity and mineral and the finish confirms the wellbalanced aromas presented on the nose.
- 2022 Hermes Diactoros Il Omina Romana, Lazio IGP £39
Ripe exotic fruit, citrus zest, white pepper, magnolia, herbs, all supported by a fresh breath of eucalyptus honey, fresh and saline the long mineral persistence
- 2022 Pinot Bianco Colterenzio, Alto Adige DOC £40
Fresh, apple white from Italy's far north, with a dollop of honey balancing out the crisp acidity of all those fresh green apples.
- 2022 Urra Di Mare Mandrarossa, Sicilia DOC £42
This wine has a straw-yellow color and boasts of a rich aroma of citrus fruits, accompanied by notes of pineapple, passion fruit, and green apple.
- 2022 Gavi di Gavi Fontanafredda, Piedmont DOCG £42
Gavi di Gavi is one of the most fashionable white wines Italy makes and this delicately floral example, exuding lemons, lilies of the valley and green apples, makes it easy to see why.
- 2020 Nosiola Cesconi, Trentino, Alto Adige IGT £44
The nose is fresh and lively, expressing the wine's mountain character, with notes of grapefruit and elderberry. The palate is savoury but delicate; the moderate alcohol content and high acidity enhancing its depth and finish.
- 2023 Pomino Bianco Frescobaldi, Toscana DOC £45
The bouquet is rich with floral notes, with honeysuckle as the prevalent aroma. This is, in part, thanks to the wine being aged on lees in the months following vinification.
- 2022 Vermentino La Spinetta, Toscana IGT £45
Terricciola's soil is sandy and rich in marine sediments and which gives our Vermentino an incredibly aromatic profile. The wine has notes of Mediterranean scrub blended with mineral and white flower scents. The flavors are a perfect match of fresh and savory.

ITALY WHITES

2022 Vernaccia Selvabianca S. Chiara, Toscana, San Gimignano DOCG £45
The bouquet is fine and fresh with apple hints and flower scents, whilst, on the tongue, it is sapid, very pleasant and well-structured with a well balanced acidity.

2022 Capitel Croce Anselmi, Veneto IGT £45
Spicy white from northern Italy, fragrant with vanilla, creamy and appealing, with a mouth-watering citrus hit on the palate and a faint, refreshing breath of menthol.

2022 Timorasso La Spinetta, Piemonte DOC £45
A wine with unbelievable structure and surprising longevity. Delicate citrus and floral notes sing in concert these are also present when you taste the wine. On the palate it is savory and generous, it finishes clean.

2021 Muller Thurgau Kettmair, Alto Adige DOC £47
Pale straw-yellow colour with an intense, reasonably aromatic nose showing notes of nutmeg, nettle and white peach. Fresh, full, agreeable, lengthy finish.

2022 Soave Classico Vintage Bertani, Veneto DOC £47
In this wonderfully aromatic Soave from Italy's Veneto sage and mint, elderflower and cherry blossom waft into the nostrils, followed by an appetising shot of peach and apricot on the tongue.

2020 Sorrentino Vigna Lapillo Lacryma Christi, Campania DOC £49
The Vesuvio Lachryma Christi is made from Caprettone with 20% Falanghina grown at 500 meters above the sea. It displays beautiful aromatics and is remarkably powerful and structured with an exceptionally long finish.

2022 Lugana Vigneto Massoni Santa Cristina, Veneto DOC £52
Its multifaceted nose is aromatic, fresh, and fruity, with notes of grape, peach, citron, grapefruit, and a hint of pineapple, which adds tropical character. On the palate, the wine is approachable, fresh, and has good minerality.

2021 Greco Di Tufo Salvatore Mollettieri Campania DOCG £55
The grapes are harvested in mid October by hand. Fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks at a controlled temperatures, followed by a maturation of 12 months in steel and other 2 months in the bottle.

2022 Chardonnay Planeta, Sicilia DOC £75
A rich, golden Chardonnay that bundles yellow peaches, acacia honey and a touch of marzipan into a net of fine-thread acidity, then hits you with a homely waft of toast.

ROSE WINE

2022 Rose' Planeta, Sicilia DOC £34
The wine is silky smooth, light and fresh with no angularity and a beautiful finish.

2022 Costaripa Rosamara, Lombardia, Valtenesi DOC £45
Very light blooming pink, characteristic of very soft, delicate vinification. Inviting, well-rounded yet at the same time subtly elegant. Hints of hawthorn, sour cherry and pomegranate. A silky, harmonious texture, rich in excellent persistence and taste. Slight aftertaste of bitter almonds

ORANGE WINE

2022 Orange Inzolia Organic, Tenute Orestyadi, Sicilia IGT £36
On the nose, the aromas of wild flowers, herbs, almonds and orange peel stand out. On the palate, it is soft and savory, with a balanced acid base, enriched by notes of citrus fruits, dried apricots, white peaches and sweet spices.

ITALY REDS

- 2022 Barbera Amonte Volpi Piemonte IGT £27
Bright, fruity, easy-drinking red, cheerfully giving out blueberries, cherries and raspberries.
- 2022 Sangiovese Lungarotti, Umbria IGT £32
It has aromas of a green spices, pepper and cinnamon typical of the varietal, with slightly buttery notes of marasca cherry.
- 2021 La Segreta Nero D' Avola Planeta, Sicilia DOC £35
Rich, spicy Nero d'Avola grape indigenous to Sicily, with cocoa, spice and plush dark fruit.
- 2022 Terra Vera Gran Sasso, Montepulciano D'Abruzzo DOC £37
Valentino and his team work closely with their growers to produce a deep-coloured, clean and plummy young Montepulciano.
- 2022 Cantine Belisario, Lacrima di Morra, Marche DOC £37
Intense, rose, geranium and violet perfumes are followed by notes of myrtle and cinnamon. Medium bodied and dry while fresh and fruity on the palate with balsamic hints.
- 2020 Diana Nemorensis Omina Romana, Lazio IGT £37
Intense and fruit forward, ripe aromas of red plum, blackcurrant, cranberry, with sweet spiciness and hints of vanilla, cloves and dark-bitter chocolate.
- 2022 Castiglioni Chianti Frescobaldi, Toscana DOCG £38
It has a pleasantly fruity bouquet, with notes that bring to mind strawberry, maraschacherry, raspberry and fig; the fruit is accompanied by delightful floral and Mediterranean aromas.
- 2022 Rosso Di Montepulciano Poliziano, Toscana DOC £38
Intense damson, black cherry, fine tannins, refreshing acidity, subtle oak. Unique Rosso di Montepulciano, not declassified Vino Nobile. Carefully chosen vines for sumptuous, rich delight.
- 2021 Primitivo di Manduria Lu Rappaio Masca del Tacco, Puglia DOC £42
In the glass the wine appears ruby red with purple hints. The nose reveals hints of violet, wild blackberry, ripe strawberries and rosemary. The sip is soft and structured.
- 2021 Cannunau Costera Argiolas, Sardegna DOC £44
It shows typical notes of ripe strawberries, black cherries, herbs and spices. It's enveloping and intense, with a good structure, velvety tannins and an excellent balance.
- 2022 Valpolicella Bertani, Veneto DOC £44
Violet red colour. Intense notes of black currant red, plum, raspberry, black cherry and spice. On the palate the wine opens, fresh with a good balance between acidity, sweetness and tannin.
- 2019 Crocevento Pinot Nero Garda Monte Zovo, Veneto, Garda DOC £44
The nose is conquered by the scents of undergrowth and red fruits among which plums and ripe cherries stand out. The sip is persuasive and soft, structured, with balanced tannins.
- 2021 Cerasuolo di Vittoria Planeta, Sicilia DOCG £45
Furiously energetic, full of wild strawberries, mulberries and pomegranates, with a scattering of black pepper and a squeeze of sweet cherry juice.



ITALY REDS

- 2015 Robeo Toscana Carus Vini, Toscana IGT £45
This wine exudes notes of black cherry, black currant, leather, meat, red plum and spice with a tinge of graphite.
- 2019 Montefalco Vigna Flamina Caprai, Umbria DOC £46
Aroma of Marasca, cherry, wild flowers, pepper and nutmeg . Taste: full bodied, elegant thanks to the refined tannins.
- 2020 Allegrini Palazzo Della Torre Veneto IGT £46
On the nose, this wine reveals distinct notes of berries, aromatic herbs, spices and vanilla. The textured palate is underpinned by sweet, polished tannins that linger on the long and intriguing finish.
- 2022 Langhe Nebbiolo Ascheri, Piemonte DOC £47
Ruby red colour with garnet reflections. Full bodied bouquet, with a delicate violet scent. Dry on the palate, yet velvety, harmonious and very persistent at the same time. Very well balanced, with distinct class and style.
- 2019 Ludovico Rosso Tenute Orestyadi, Sicilia DOC £48
Full and fruity Sicilian red, spilling over with prunes, mulberry and black cherry, the dark fruit complementing spicy aromas of liquorice, tobacco and pepper.
- 2021 Susamaniello Varvaglione, Puglia IGP £48
Intense Primitivo from southern Italy, lush with blackberries and currants and elegantly perfumed with nutmeg, chocolate, liquorice and vanilla.
- 2019 Collio Cabernet Franc Russiz Superiore Friuli Collio DOC £50
The aromatic profile ranges from red berry fruit such as sour cherry and blackcurrant, to the vegetable of pepper. On the palate it is important and classy, with a rich, broad and pleasant body.
- 2020 Vino Nobile Di Montepulciano, Toscana DOCG £60
Deep-coloured, juicy and intense, with flavours of dark cherries and ripe plums, it has the richness, tannic structure and balance to reward keeping, even if with suitable decanting it can be enjoyed more immediately.
- 2013 Vesevo, Taurasi 'Ensis', Campania DOCG £62
Deep ruby red in colour. On the nose is a complex wine with aromas redolent of red berry fruits and hints of vanilla, firm palate but smooth tannins and a clean, dry finish.
- 2019 Barolo di Serralunga d'Alba Fontanafredda, Piemonte DOCG £79
Full-bodied, velvety and intense, this Barolo is heady with vanilla, dried roses and woodland undergrowth.
- 2017 Brunello di Montalcino Il Poggione, Toscana DOCG £88
A seductive Brunello di Montalcino, so fragrant with fruit, leather and spice you could wear it as aftershave.
- 2020 Amarone Valpantena Bertani, Veneto DOCG £89
Deep dark ruby with a violet rim. Notes of black and sour cherries, berries, spices and dried fruit. The palate is creamy with soft tannins and integrated oak. A lighter, fruitier and younger version of Bertani's icon Amarone Classico.

2022 Bourgogne Aligote'Domaine Gueguen, Burgundy <i>Appealing floral notes on the nose. The palate comes alive with lemon sherbert and green apple.</i>	£40
2019 Riesling, Trimbach, Alsace <i>Dry, elegant and restrained, with a deliciously food-friendly bite.</i>	£49
2022 Chablis, Domaine de Vauroux, Burgundy <i>Crisp and stylish, with peach, pear and steel on the finish.</i>	£57

2022 Weingut am Kaiserbaum, Gewurztraminer Riesling, Pfalz, Germany <i>The acidity and minerality of Riesling is offset by Gewürztraminer's unctuous lychees and aromatic floral notes</i>	£45
2022 Valdeorras Godello 'Louro Do Bolo, Galicia, Spain <i>It has intense aromas of citrus fruits, wild mountain flowers, hints of fennel and flinty nuances.</i>	£49

2023 Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, Glazebrook, New Zealand <i>Crisp and zesty, citrus and grapefruit, crunchy green apple, juicy peach and passionfruit with fresh garden herbs.</i>	£38
2021 Chardonnay, Bogle Vineyards, California, USA <i>A treat of a Chardonnay from California, with green apples, pears and pineapples on the nose and butterscotch and vanilla.</i>	£55
2019 Chenin Blanc/Verdelho, Momento, Cape South Coast, South Africa <i>Notes of brioche and tart lemon curd lead to a long, pithy finish.</i>	£55

- 2022 Les Mougeottes Pinot Noir, IGP Pays d'Oc, Languedoc-Roussillon £34
Clean and precise bouquet with black cherries and raspberry aromas, medium-bodied with sappy red berry fruit.
- 2021 Montjau Cote Du Rhone Vignerons Ardechois, Rhone Valley £39
Chocolatey, spicy nose and velvety rich cassis and black cherry palate finishing on a peppery note.
- 2020 Chateau Dubard Bel-Air, Puisseguin Saint-Emilion, Bordeaux £49
A charming wine, full of ripe plum and blueberry fruit, supported by toasty oak. Ample-textured, with juicy fruit balanced by firm tannins and great structure.

REST OF EUROPE REDS

- 2020 Douro Red, Quinta do Crasto, Douro valley, Portugal £39
Dark and richly aromatic, with heady flavours of ripe red berries, violet and spice.
- 2019 Rioja Crianza, Sierra Cantabria, Rioja, Spain £44
Smooth, elegant Rioja, brimming with ripe cherries and other red fruit, the nose a sophisticated combination of spice, cocoa and a wisp of smoke.
- 2019 Finca Museum, Cigales Reserva, Castilla y Leon, Spain £45
Aromas of red berries, blackcurrants and cranberries. The red fruit continues onto the palate, and is accompanied by savoury spice and liquorice. The finish is long, with hints of roasted hazelnut.
- 2019 Crianza Organic, Cruz de Alba, Ribeira Del Duero, Spain £52
On the nose it is rich in nuances: intense, fresh, with sparks of ripe fruit and spices, integrated with a balanced, elegant and pleasant oakiness. On the palate it is silky, full bodied and intense, long finish.

NEW WORLD REDS

- 2022 Don David El Esteco Reserva Malbec, Salta, Argentina £39
Dried red berries, plum jam, acidity of redcurrants, sweetness of vanilla and an undertone of dark chocolate.
- 2019 Reserve Pat's Garden, Ken Forrester Wines, Western Cape, South Africa £45
Hints of coffee, chocolate and ripe berry fruits supported by smooth, firm tannin for soft early drinking.
- 2022 MOMO Pinot Noir Organic, Seresin Estate, New Zealand £47
Ripe red-cherry flavour, spicy undertones and a textural, dry finish with charming fruit lingering on the aftertaste.
- 2020 Sonoma Cabernet Sauvignon, Louis Martini, California, USA £55
Yummy with black plums and blackcurrants and lightly spiced on the nose.
- 2021 Yallingup Cabernet Sauvignon, Nocturne Margaret River, Australia £60
Deep, dark fruit flavors characteristic of cabernet sauvignon, with notes of blackcurrant, plum, and hints of cedar and spice.



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SELECTION OF FINE RED WINES

2019 Mercurey 1er Cru Clos des Barraults Rouge, Michel Juillot, Burgundy, France £80
Classic Mercurey Premier Cru, a concentrated rush of fruit on the palate and an appealing woody perfume on the nose; cherries and redcurrants blend with cedar and oak, to exciting effect.

2018 Maragux Origine De Demistral , Denis Lurton Bordeaux, France £80
Spicy, alluring Bordeaux red, offering a persistent perfume of wildflower and a mouthful of crushed blackcurrant.

2018 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Zenato, Veneto, Italy £130
From a quality-focused family winery, this is big and powerful, even for an Amarone. Rich and plush textured with luscious chocolate, licorice, prune, nutty and floral flavours.

2019 Turriga Isola dei Nuraghi Argiolas, Sardinia, Italy £130
This classic expression displays raspberry, tar, hazelnut, dried fig, asphalt and some crushed chalk. The wine is streamlined and compact in terms of mouthfeel , giving us an accessible Brunello from Montalcino estate.

2020 Nuits-Saint-Georges Joseph Drouhin, Burgundy, France £140
Deep red colour. The aromas are powerful and elegant, with notes of cherry and blackberry, as well as hints of cedar wood evolving towards gamey touches. On the palate: beautiful balance between structure and softness.

2017 Saint-Julien, Chateau Talbot 4eme Cru Classe, Bordeaux, France £185
Talbot has produced an elegant, fresh and carefully structured 2017. This has plenty of finesse and rich black fruit flavours.



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
